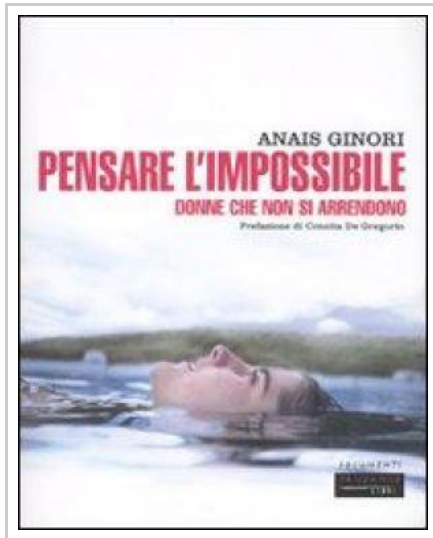




## Pensare l'impossibile. Donne che non si arrendono.
